



Dear Residents of Langdon Place:

RE: SEE REVISION TO WASTE MANAGEMENT PICK-UP DATES

Due to a potential 18% price increase from Rumpke, The City of Langdon Place has changed weekly trash hauling vendors from Rumpke to Waste Management. Langdon Place will maintain the same price structure we have been enjoying for the past 10 years and we will receive the same great trash pickup service from Waste Management.

Here is the how the program will work in the next 2 weeks:

1. Waste Management will drop off one of 2 containers this week starting Saturday, Sept. 29th at each resident of Langdon Place, and complete delivery by Saturday, Oct. 6th. The 2-Green Waste Management containers will be labeled; one for "Trash Only" and the other for "Recycle Only". Please push to a spot on your property for use starting the week of Oct. 8th.

2. Waste Management REVISED Trash, Recycling & Yard Waste Pick Up Dates for City of Langdon Place:

- **TRASH Only:** Waste Management will start their weekly pick-up of Trash on MONDAY, Oct. 8th, then Every Monday until further notice.
- **RECYCLE Only:** Waste Management will pick-up Recycling starting on Wednesday, Oct. 10th, then Every 2-Weeks on Wednesday until further notice. Note you will have a Recycling container that is larger and the same size as your Trash container, we hope this better meets your recycling needs.
- **YARD WASTE Only:** Waste Management will start their weekly pick-up Yard Waste on Wednesday, Oct. 10th, then Every Wednesday until further notice.

Note: The Waste Management Dates may change back to our traditional Friday pick-up for all 3 services, I will know more by end of this year.

3. Rumpke will make their last pick-up of Trash, Recycle and Yard Waste on Friday, Oct. 5th. Fill up your Trash & Recycling containers and push to the curb as usual and Rumpke will bring in flat-bed trucks, load up the full containers and permanently remove from your property. Starting the week of Oct. 8th the only 2 containers you will have on your property for Trash & Recycling will be 2-Green Waste Management containers, one for "Trash Only" and one for "Recycle Only". ***With "Yard Waste", as before, you may put your Yard Waste in the brown recyclable paper bags that are available from various retailers. You may purchase your own reusable plastic trash can from a store, like Home Depot, and Waste Management will empty weekly and return to curb for your reuse. I would suggest marking this personal can "Yard Waste" and include your home address number as well.***
